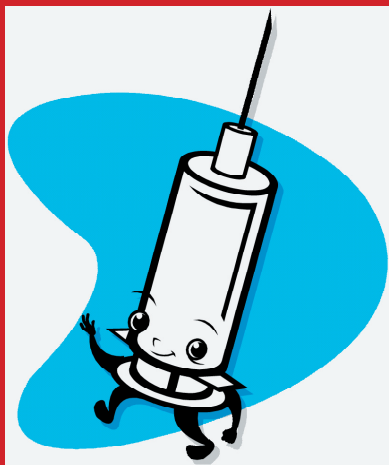


Please don't "stick" us

Recently, there has been an increase in the amount of needles, syringes and lancets (called "sharps") in our recycling. Sharps pose a health hazard to workers who sort your recycling by hand. Please help us avoid injuries-dispose of your sharps properly.

Sharps NEVER belong in your
recycling or garbage carts!

DISPOSING OF SHARPS:

For storage, use an approved sharps container. If one is not available, use a plastic bottle with a screw-top lid, such as a detergent bottle. Label it, “WARNING - SHARPS — DO NOT RECYCLE.”

Take sharps to one of these solid waste collection facilities to dispose of them for free:
